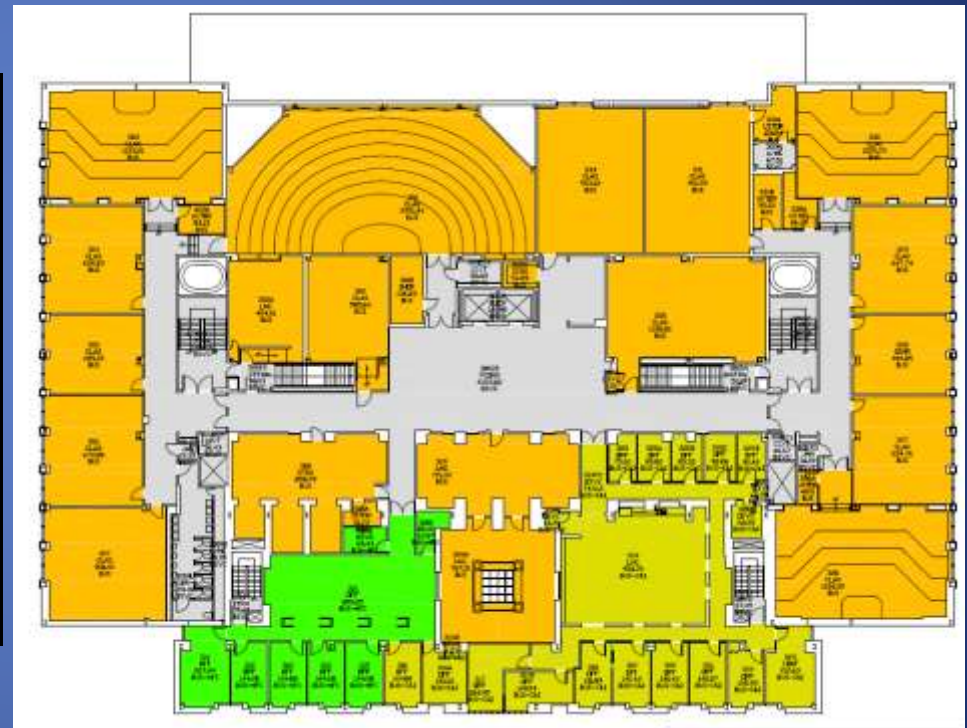
Uris 1st Floor



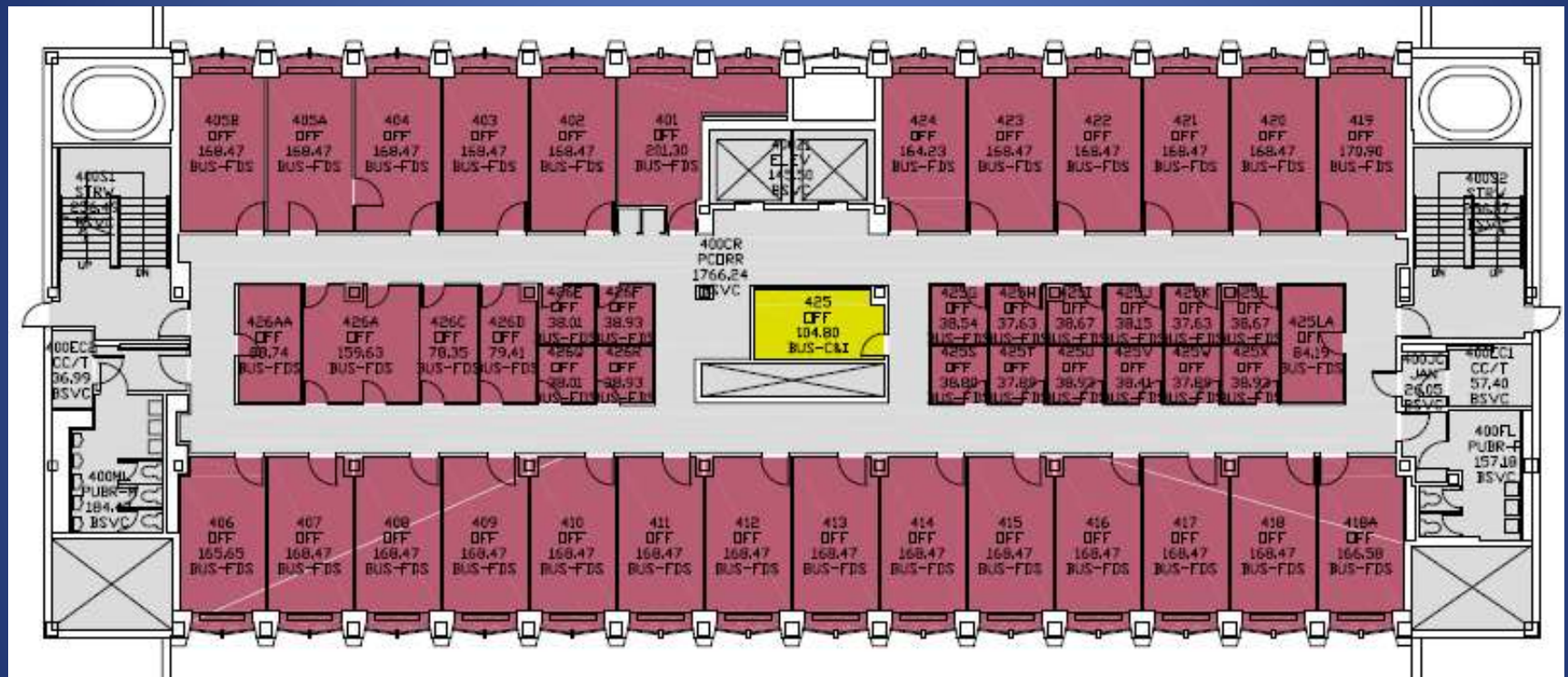
Uris 2nd Floor



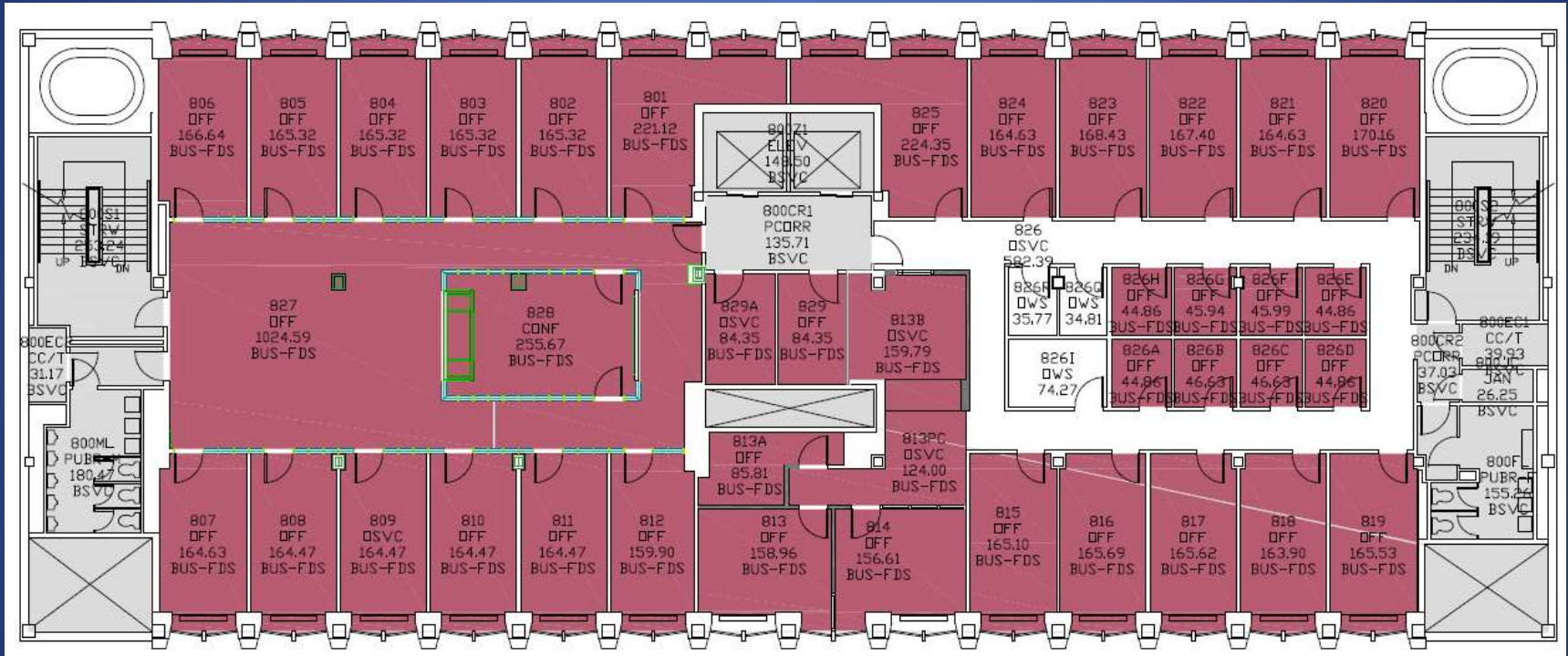
